Declaration of entitlement to license at the basic goods rate of Vehicle Excise Duty

This form must be completed at vehicle licensing if:

- the vehicle is being licensed in the Small Island Vehicles tax class for the first time (i.e. at first registration or change of tax class)
- the registered keeper is different from that shown on the vehicle's Registration Certificate
- you are the registered keeper but you are also notifying a change of address

You must also present your Operator Licence with this form to confirm the address at which the vehicle is based

Licensing applications must be submitted to one of the DVLA local offices listed overleaf.

I am entitled to license vehicle registration mark _____ commencing on _____ at the basic goods rate of duty because it qualifies as a small islands goods vehicle, as defined in the Vehicle Excise and Registration Act 1994 [VERA] (as amended) paragraph 18 of Schedule 1 being:

- a goods vehicle on any island designated under The Vehicle Excise Duty (Designation of Small Islands) Order 1995 as amended
- and
- a goods vehicle up to 17,000kg revenue weight normally kept at a base or centre on any designated small island having use of mainland roads (para 18(3))
- or
- a goods vehicle over 17,000kg revenue weight normally kept at a base or centre on any designated small island where use of that vehicle on the mainland is subject to a 5km distance restriction from a mainland port for the purposes of loading and unloading (para 18(2)).
